- Continuing to respond to Provider Access Legislation

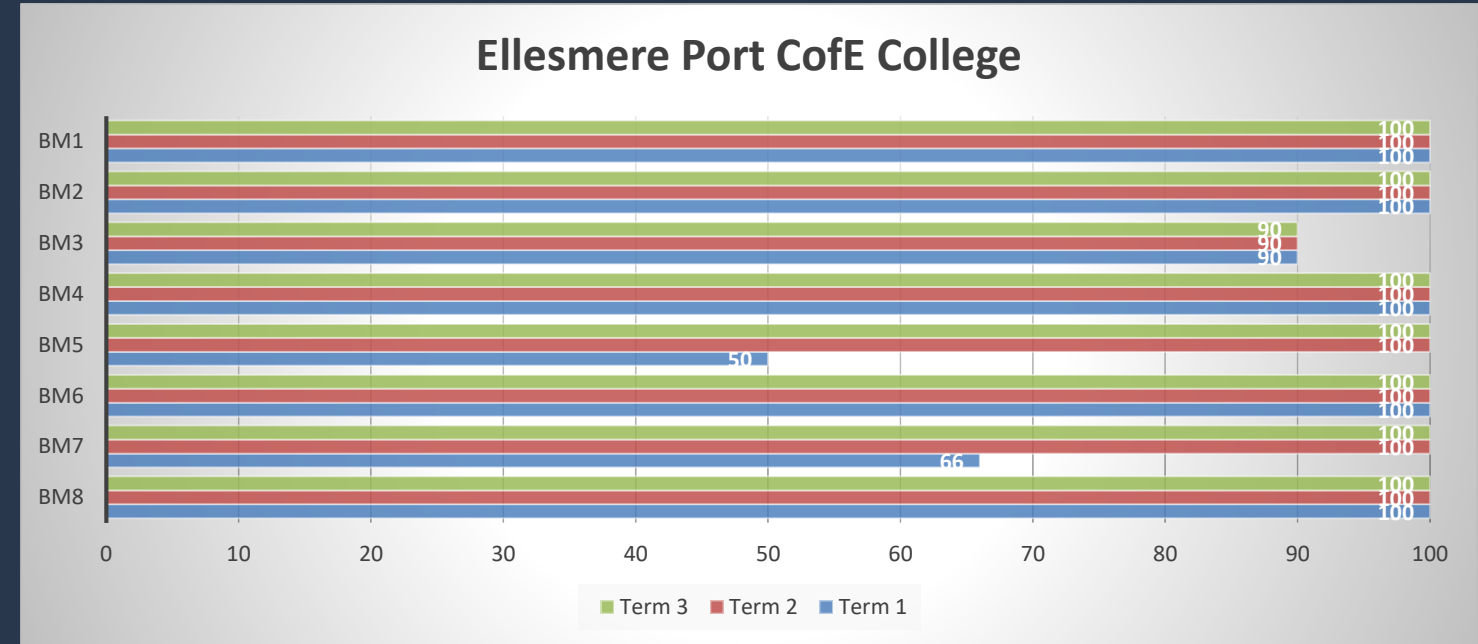
Development Areas
