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

What do I need to know?

- There are 5 LPs across the year.
- They are colour coded and match the colour of the LPs that the pupils have in their books
- All LPs for all Year groups and all subjects you can see on our website under "Learning Programmes" as well as in your child's book
- The programme is flexible and contains many opportunities to close gaps in your child's knowledge OR expand their knowledge

Our Vision:

What do I need to know?

- They contain 2 formative assessments within each LP where staff can check progress, then set a PUPIL RESPONSE TASK (PRT) for the pupils to complete in class to close any gaps in knowledge
- They have the homework set for each week on them
- They contain the LORIC Focus of the LP AND the moral virtue Focus
- The contain an FFET award opportunity for every subject (5 across the Year)
- LP2, LP4 and LP5 all contain a SUMMATIVE assessment.
