FAQs for the Conway Centre Residential Trip

- 1. What is the duration of the residential trip?

- 2. What should my child pack?

- The students will engage in a variety of educational and recreational activities, including team-building exercises, nature walks, and arts and crafts. Please refer to the itinerary.
- 7. Is there a contact number for emergencies?
