Learning Programme 1

The LORIC skill focus for this LP is: LEADERSHIP The Moral Virtues focus for this LP are: COURAGE and HUMILITY. Courage - Acting with bravery and overcoming fears. Humility - Having a modest view of oneself. What will I be learning about in this Learning Programme? You will be learning about the elements of music which are the building blocks to be able to describe, perform and create music. There will be a focus on 'pitch' as an inter-related dimension of music and you will learn how to read notes on the stave in treble clef through a variety of tasks. Where have I seen this learning before? We will continue your journey as a musician and build on knowledge from primary school using a love of music to develop their understanding across a variety of musical contexts. What could I use it for? Knowledge of the elements of music will provide pupils with key understanding of how music is put together which we will use as inter-related dimensions of music.
