What will I be learning about in this Learning Programme? This 7-week unit focuses on dynamic tactical gameplay, spatial awareness, and adaptable skill execution in basketball. Students will move away from isolated drills toward fast-paced transitional play, structured defensive systems, and variable small-sided games (such as 3v3 and 5v5) that allow all ability levels to contribute meaningfully.				
Where have I seen this learning before? "Students will build upon foundational movements and concepts from: Key Stage 3 Basketball/Netball: Basic dribbling, chest/bounce passing, footwork (pivoting), and basic shooting mechanics. Other Invasion Games: Intercepting and marking from football or rugby; tactical positioning and creating space from handball. Fitness Units: Understanding aerobic endurance, explosive power, and agility required for short-court sports." What could I use it for? The skills and tactical concepts developed here will prepare students for: KS4 Exam Moderation: Practical performance video evidence for BTEC Sport. Recreational & Community Sport: Confidence to participate in mixed-gender casual leagues, university intramural sports, or local clubs. Coaching & Event Management: Developing transferable leadership skills, communication strategies, and the ability to organize inclusive sporting activities."
